

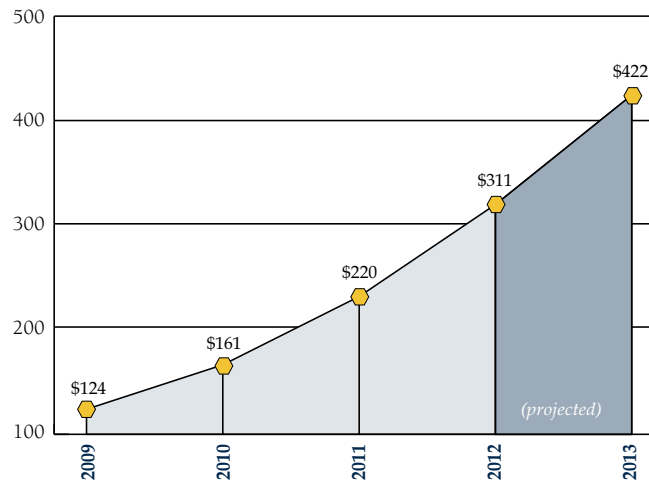
# Economic Impact of the 2013 Indiana Companies to Watch

## INCREASING IMPACT

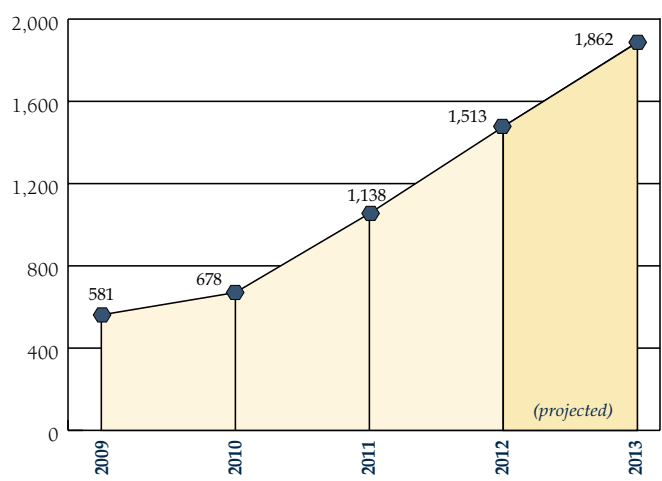
From 2009 through 2012, these companies generated \$817 million in revenue and added 933 employees (both in Indiana and out of state), reflecting a 151% increase in revenue and 161% increase in jobs for the four-year period. That translates into a 36% annual revenue growth and 39% annual growth in employees.

These companies project continued growth in 2013, with a 36% revenue increase and 23% growth in employees (both in Indiana and out of state) compared to 2012. If their projections hold, these companies will have generated \$1.2 billion in revenue and added 1,281 employees over the last five years — a 240% increase in revenue and 221% increase in jobs since 2009.
